

All Roads Lead to St. Louis Expo March 20-22

With Route 66 running through St. Louis, the organizers of the St. Louis Stamp Expo are joining in the Centennial celebration of that historic highway—and inviting collectors to “meet us in St. Louis”.

The show will be held the weekend of March 20-22 at the Renaissance St. Louis Airport Hotel, 9801 Natural Bridge Road, St. Louis, Missouri. Show hours are Friday 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturday 10 to 6 and Sunday 10 to 3.

The Expo features more than 40 dealers offering stamps and covers from around the world as well as a USPS substation. The Centennial of Route 66 theme will be carried out on show cachets and cancels.

There also will be 160 Frames of exhibits. The St. Louis Stamp Expo is part of the World Series of Philately, so the winner qualifies for the annual APS Champion of Champions competition in August at the Great American Stamp Show, and visitors can be assured that a high

level of material with a variety of collecting interests will be on display.

Collecting information also will be available to beginners of all ages. For youngsters, a Youth Room will be staffed by club members throughout the three days of the show.

All children under the age of 16 will be admitted to the Expo free of charge. The admission fee for adults is \$5 per person, good for all three days of the show. Free parking at the show hotel is available with validation. The Renaissance hotel room rate is \$118 plus tax, deadline for reservations is February 26.
